About the Passover Lamb

- The instructions to the Hebrews in Egypt were to take a **lamb** to prepare the Passover.
- The offering was to be **perfect**.
- The purpose for the annual sacrifice made by the high priest on Yom Kippur, or the Day of Atonement, was to ceremonially cleanse all of the people of their sins.
- Instructions about the time of sacrifice.
- Instructions about the **condition** of the sacrifice.

Hebrews 9:22 Leviticus 17:10-14

Jesus was not a plan "B"

First, Jesus was not a New Testament creation

- Several places in the old testament, God speaks of Himself as "us"
 Genesis 1:26 Genesis 3:22 Genesis 11:7 Isaiah 6:8
- Jesus appears several times in the Old Testament in what theologians call Christophany.
